



Education Funding: Striving Readers

What do you need to know?

What is it?

The Striving Readers Comprehensive Literacy grant is a federal grant focused on advancing literacy skills for students from birth through Grade 12. The emphasis is on serving the academic literacy needs of disadvantaged children.

How are funds distributed?

During the 2017-18 school year, school districts in awarded states will partner with early childhood providers to compete for a 3-year subgrant. While states can issue more specific funding priorities, preference will be given to applicants serving a high percent of children that are economically disadvantaged, English learners, or have disabilities.

What can be funded?

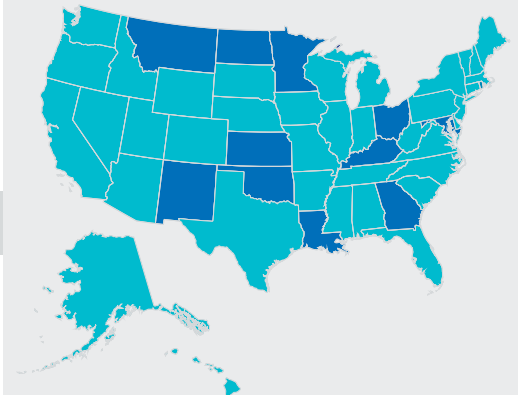
Striving Readers projects will provide high-quality comprehensive literacy instruction for disadvantaged children through evidence-based interventions, professional development, and curriculum. Grant requirements and allowable expenditures will vary by state.

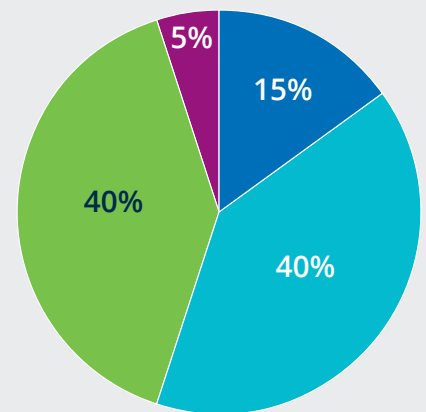
