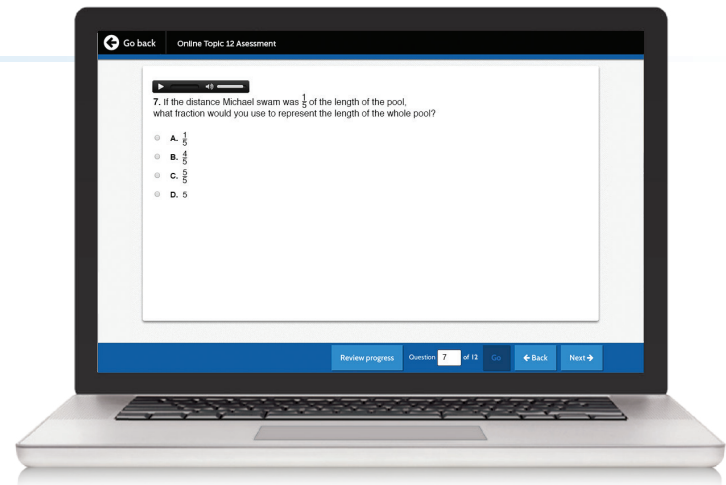


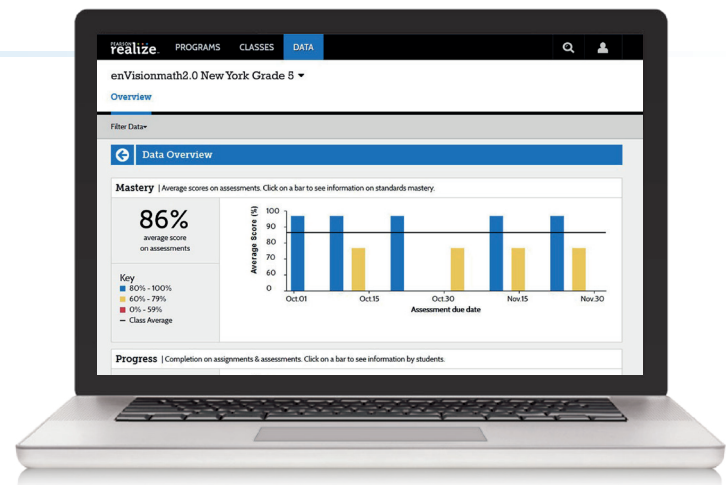
## Assessments

- Types of Assessments** The table on the next page describes the variety of assessments offered in **enVisionmath2.0**. Note the following:
  - **Online assessments can be customized** as needed.
  - **Math Practices Proficiency Rubrics** are provided and can be used at any time. (See page 54.)
  - **Scoring rubrics and sample student work** are included for some assessments in the Assessment Sourcebook.
- Types of Assessment Items** The formats of the assessment items, which prepare students for major tests, include the following:
  - **Selected response**, e.g., single response, multiple response
  - **Constructed response**, e.g., short response, extended response
  - **Technology-enhanced items**, e.g., drag and drop, drop-down choices
  - **Performance tasks**, hand scored or machine scored



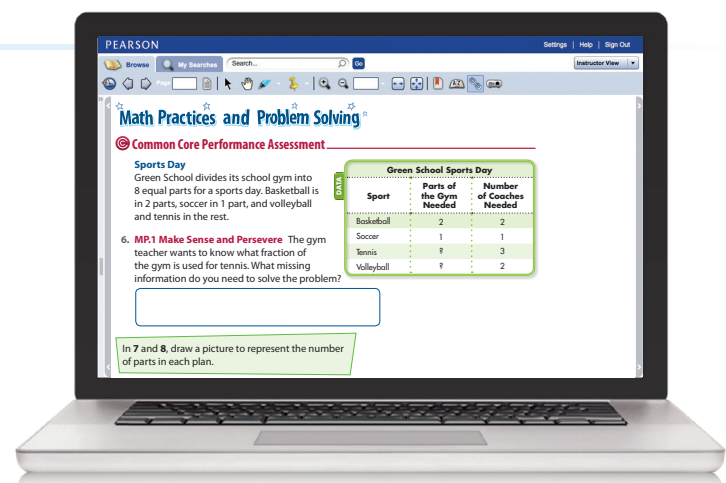
## Assessment Data

- Assessment Reports** A variety of auto-generated assessment reports are available for online assessments.
  - **Individual and class views** of progress are provided in an easy-to-view format.
  - **New York Standards mastery reports** show individual students' mastery or classwide mastery for each standard.
- Using Assessment Data** You can use the assessment data to organize students into groups for purposes of making instructional decisions and assigning differentiation resources as described on pages 74–75.



## Assessment Practice

- Assessment Practice in Lessons** Every lesson in Grades 1–5 includes practice items in formats that help prepare students for major tests. Math Practices and Problem Solving lessons in Grades K–5 include opportunities for students to engage specific math practices as they solve problems in performance-based assessments.
- Next Generation Assessment Practice, Grades 3–5** A Next Generation Assessment Practice Test and two 3/4-Year Practice Performance Tasks are provided online and in the Assessment Sourcebook.
