MyPaint	mypaint.org	MyPaint is a free, open-source drawing program with digital tools that replicate the look of pencils, paints, and charcoal. Software is available on Windows, Mac, and Linux. Hash layers, a color wheel, and a brush library. Other features include blending, ink brushes, and full-screen mode. The software also supports creating designs on smartphones or tablets.
